

## TOP 10 PRESCRIPTION DRUGS LOSING EXCLUSIVITY IN 2024



Drug Name	Treatment Indication(s)	How It Works	Anticipated Generic Availability
<b>Sprycel (dasatinib)</b>	Certain types of leukemia, including chronic myeloid leukemia and acute lymphoblastic leukemia	It works by blocking the action of abnormal proteins that cause cancer cells to multiply.	September 2024
<b>Tysabri (natalizumab)</b>	Multiple sclerosis and Crohn's disease	This monoclonal antibody inhibits the movement of immune cells across the blood-brain barrier, reducing inflammation and damage to the nervous system.	TBD 2024
<b>Myrbetriq (mirabegron)</b>	Overactive bladder	This beta-3 adrenergic agonist relaxes a muscle in the bladder known as the detrusor, increasing bladder capacity.	TBD 2024
<b>Victoza (liraglutide)</b>	Blood sugar control in adults with type 2 diabetes Reduces risk of major cardiovascular events in adults with type 2 diabetes and heart disease	This glucagon-like peptide-1 (GLP-1) receptor agonist increases insulin secretion, decreases glucagon secretion, and slows the emptying of the stomach.	June 2024
<b>Emflaza (deflazacort)</b>	Duchenne muscular dystrophy	It works by reducing inflammation and altering the immune response.	Currently available (February 2024)
<b>Sandostatin (octreotide)</b>	Severe diarrhea and flushing episodes associated with certain types of tumors	It works by stopping or slowing the release of several hormones and other secretions.	TBD 2024
<b>Dulera (mometasone/ formoterol)</b>	Asthma	It reduces inflammation and relaxes muscles in the airways to improve breathing.	TBD 2024
<b>Oxtellar (oxcarbazepine)</b>	Anticonvulsant used to treat partial seizures in adults and children with epilepsy	It stabilizes electrical activity in the brain.	September 2024
<b>Venofer (iron sucrose)</b>	Iron deficiency anemia in patients with chronic kidney disease	It works by replenishing iron stores in the body, which are essential for producing red blood cells.	TBD 2024
<b>Prolensa (bromfenac)</b>	Inflammation and pain reduction after cataract surgery	This nonsteroidal anti-inflammatory drug (NSAID) reduces hormones that cause inflammation and pain.	Currently available (January 2024)

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
